Sancerre Silex, Philippe Girard, Loire, France, 2018.

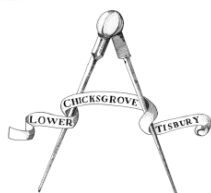
Grown next to Sancerre's best-known vineyards at Chavignol, a wonderful match for any fish.
